

# Berlin

SHORT FALL EXCURSION | 10TH - 12TH OCTOBER 2025



In Fall 2025, we will travel to Berlin to visit the exhibition *The Bronzes of San Casciano dei Bagni. A Sensation from the Mud* at the James-Simon-Galerie. The objects on display—dating from the 3rd century BCE to the 4th century CE—were discovered in a pool of water beside a still-active thermal spring. This ancient pool was the heart of an Etruscan-Roman sanctuary, where the sick sought healing and parents asked the gods to protect their children. The statues and smaller objects on view were votive offerings made to the deities worshipped at the site.

We will also visit other major museums in Berlin. Travel and accommodation will be arranged by the Institute. Participants are asked to contribute 30% of the total cost, approximately €150 per person.
